WHAT IS HOMOEOPATHY?

According to the World Health Organisation Homoeopathy is the second most used medicine in the world. It is a complete system of medicine developed by German physician and chemist, Dr Samuel Hahnemann (1755-1843), based on the principle of "like cures like". This law or principle has been used in medicine and healing since ancient times where the action of substances that could produce symptoms in a healthy individual employed to treat similar symptoms in a sick person. Thus homoeopathic treatment is credited with stimulating the body's ability to fight infection and susceptibility to disease.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

DIVERSITY ADDS TO A SENSE OF COMMUNITY

At Nature Care College, we are committed to welcoming, nurturing and developing growth. Admission to Nature Care College is based on program entry requirements. This may include but is not limited to academic merit, knowledge and skills achieved through formal courses of study, work experience, mature age entry and the potential for tertiary study.

Selection Process: For Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses, Nature Care does not require students to have any specific prior knowledge or a particular University Admissions Index (UAI) for course entry.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- To qualify for admission course entry is through high school matriculation or mature age entry of 21 years and over
- Writing and submitting a personal statement indicating your special areas of interest, any related experience you may have, and why you wish to undertake the course (limited to one A4 page)
- Applicants may be requested to participate in a phone or in person appointment with a Course Advisor prior to final selection

YOUR PAYMENT OPTIONS

VET FEE-HELP The Advanced Diploma of Homoeopathy is fully funded by VET FEE-HELP. Students can obtain an Australian Government student loan for all or part of their tuition fees. Please refer to www.naturecare.com.au for further information on VET FEE-HELP.

PAY TERM BY TERM AS YOU GO Study programs can be structured to suit your individual lifestyle needs. Course fees are charged on a term by term basis & are dependant on the number of units of study you enrol into each term.

SPREAD THE COST OF YOUR COURSE THROUGHOUT THE TERM Payment Plans provide an option for students to spread the cost of your course fees through out the term, in weekly or fortnightly instalments. A 50% deposit on the terms fees is payable at enrolment, the remaining fees are then spread through out the term. A 10% surcharge applies to the outstanding balance for the use of a Payment Plan.

A typical day in practice might consist of new cases (typically a one to two hour in-depth assessment) and follow up consultations (typically half to one hour evaluating the client's progress and deciding the next step in treatment). You will also treat acute cases such as fevers, coughs and the flu. Other cases might include disease prevention, travel remedies and treatment pre and post surgery.
