## Homoeopathy 1C

### DISTANCE/BLENDED LEARNING

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	Homoeopathy 1C continues the study of Homoeopathic Materia Medica both with acute or first aid remedies and chronic remedies. We expand your knowledge of therapeutic prescribing while studying remedies for children and trauma. The practical work again uses acute case work to develop repertory skills, and other aspects of prescribing homoeopathic remedies.
<b>DURATION</b>	One term (12 weeks) approximately 24 learning hours.

Outline the application of homoeopathic case taking and treatment in acute illnesses.</li> <li>6. Outline the application of homoeopathic case taking and treatment in chronic illnesses.</li> <li>7. Explain the concept and use of Homoeopathic Materia Medica.</li> <li>8. Outline the administration of a homoeopathic remedy.</li> <li>9. Apply the therapeutic method of selecting remedies for acute cases.</li> <li>10. Use the Homoeopathic Repertory and Repertory sheets to select a remedy for an acute case.</li> </ol>
<b>TEACHING METHOD</b>	<p>This subject will be studied by the method known as "Distance/Blended Learning". This form of study involves your completion of all learning outcomes without formal attendance at lectures or other types of classes.</p> <p>The benefits of this system are considerable as it contributes significant flexibility to your study program. It also encourages students to take responsibility for their own learning, enhancing those mandatory skills of self-education. There will be considerable support from the College to aid you in your studies.</p> <p>A tutor will be available to answer any academic questions students may have. Details regarding this will be in the information and instruction sheet that will be sent to you upon enrolment.</p>

**Synthesis:** This is your Repertory. It is expensive but necessary. It is essential for 1B, 1C etc; you will need it for your exams in modules 1B and 1C. The current edition is 9.1, but 7.1 or 8.1 are perfectly OK.

**Materia Medica:** Phatak is recommended because it is very reliable and is inexpensive. There are many other Materia Medica you could choose; please consult the list of Materia Medica in the Recommended Reading below. Hahnemann's Chronic Diseases, Rowan and Allen's Keynotes would not be suitable. If you are enrolled in the Homoeopathic Diploma or Degree courses, consider Vermeulen's Concordant. Homoeopathic books vary greatly in price so compare prices before you buy. Look for second hand books especially Synthesis.
