## Astrology Transit Workshop

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	Transits are the primary tool used to make astrological predictions. This one day workshop covers the basic transiting movements of the planets in our solar system and explains how this information is used in conjunction with the birth chart to make astrological predictions.
<b>DURATION</b>	6 hours
<b>LEARNING OUTCOMES</b>	By the conclusion of the day, students should be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Define a transit</li> <li>2. Have an understanding of the different cycles of each of the planets.</li> <li>3. Describe why there appears to be direct, stationary and retrograde planetary movements</li> <li>4. Make simple predictions about what type of energetic experience may be expected from each of the planets as they transit.</li> <li>5. Explain the different planetary cycles in the context of the human life cycle</li> </ol>
<b>TEACHING METHOD</b>	The course incorporates visual aids, handouts, life examples and group participation of students to explore each individual's life journey.
