Astrology 3

DESCRIPTION	Astrology 3 is designed to fill the gap that exists from completing Astrology 1 and 2, by taking them to a completion point. By the end of Astrology 3, students will have enough information to start interpreting charts and to make simple astrological predictions.
DURATION	24 hours
LEARNING OUTCOMES	<p>By the conclusion of this Unit of Study, students should be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Identify major chart components 2. Interpret how the current placement of the planets (transits) affects the birth chart 3. Predict what might happen if a particular planet was aspecting another planet 4. Define a progression 5. Describe the difference between a transiting planet and a progressed planet 6. Calculate where the progressed Sun is in the chart by the age of the person 7. Calculate where the progressed Moon is in the chart by sign and house 8. Name the 8 phases of the lunation cycle and explain what is meant by each phase 9. Explain the difference between the lunation cycle and the progressed lunation cycle and calculate the phase of each which currently affects you. 10. Identify the major themes occurring in a chart 11. Explain chart themes by putting key words into sentences 12. How to structure and prioritise an Astrological session
