Establish an ongoing healthy relationship with different types of people. 5. Develop a treatment plan with a view to selecting, if necessary, a series of remedies. 6. Apply a knowledge of methodologies in homoeopathy; select, review and change the prescribing method according to the requirement of the case. 7. Choose potency and dose, giving consideration to patient sensitivity and minimal aggravation. 8. Select the first and subsequent prescriptions bearing in mind all of the above factors.
