Information and Support

Selection Process

Nature Care College does not require students to have any specific prior knowledge or a particular Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) for course entry. You are welcome to enrol if you are 18 years and over.

Entry Requirements

- To qualify for admission, course entry for Advanced Diploma, Professional Certificate & Certificate courses is through high school matriculation or mature age entry of 18 years and over.
- Prior to enrolment, you can request an online or telephone appointment with a Course Advisor to gain a full understanding of the courses before applying.

- Refer to Timetable & Course Outline for study guidelines. The Study Plan lists the subjects you need to enrol into for your first term of study. You enrol and pay on a term-by-term basis as you progress with your studies.
- Choose your subjects for your first term of enrolment from the Timetable.

- To reserve your place in a Course Program an initial deposit of \$200 of your first term course tuition fees together with the one off \$95.00 Course Program Enrolment Fee is required to secure your place upon enrolment.
- The remaining course fees for all subjects within the term are due by the end of the first week of term unless you have submitted a formal payment plan form.
- Before you lodge your 'Initial Application for Enrolment Form' please ensure you have read the Enrolment Terms & Conditions outlined on the back of the form.

Acceptance

- If you would like an appointment with a Course Advisor prior to enrolling, a Course Advisor will contact you to arrange a suitable time.
- Once you have submitted your completed Initial Application for Enrolment Form you will receive a Confirmation of Enrolment email confirming your enrolment

Course Program Payment Options

Nature Care has a long history of making natural therapy education accessible & open to everyone. The college offers a range of payment options to assist people with their budgets.

You enrol and pay course tuition fees on a term-by term basis.

Option 1: Receive a 5% Discount

Pay the terms course tuition fees in full upon enrolment to receive a 5% discount.

To receive the 5% discount, you must enrol three weeks prior to the start of the course

Option 2: Pay term by term as you study

You can enrol with a course deposit of \$200 & the Course Program Enrolment Fee of \$95. The balance of the terms course tuition fees is payable by the end of the first week of term.

Option 3: Payment Plan

*****For Course Programs excluding the Advanced Diplomas and the Professional Certificate of Natural Remedies.***

The benefit of a payment plan is that it helps you to budget & pay for your studies throughout the 12-week term in weekly instalments. To enrol an initial deposit of \$200 & the Course Program Enrolment Fee of \$95 is required to secure your place in the course program.

A 10% payment plan surcharge is applied to the balance which is then paid off in 12-weekly instalments throughout the term.

*****For the Advanced Diplomas and the Professional Certificate of Natural Remedies.***

The benefit of a payment plan is that it helps you to budget & pay for your studies throughout the term and the two-week term break in weekly instalments

To enrol an initial deposit of \$200 & the Course Program Enrolment Fee of \$95 is required to secure your place in the course program. The balance is paid off in 14-weekly instalments for each term of study. (no payment plan surcharge applies for these ****Course Programs**)

Option 4: Payment entire Course Programs fees in advance for a 10% discount

Pay the years course tuition fees in full upon enrolment to receive a 10% discount.

Enrolment Terms & Conditions

To enrol, return your Initial Application for Enrolment Form to Nature Care College.

1. To reserve your place in a course an initial deposit of \$200 deposit of your first term tuition fees together with the one off \$95 Course Program Enrolment Fee is required to secure your place.
2. The remaining course tuition fees for all subjects within a term, are due **by the end of the first week of term** unless you have submitted a formal payment plan form. A 10% overdue late payment penalty is applied to any outstanding balance at the end of the first week of term.
3. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable unless a subject is cancelled by Nature Care College, in this instance a full refund is provided.
4. **Cancellation/Withdrawal Policy:** Course Credits can be granted for course tuition fees paid, less a \$50 administration fee per subject provided advice of withdrawal is received in writing one week prior to the start of a subject. Please advise the reason for withdrawal with supporting documentation. Choose your courses carefully as unfortunately we cannot accept responsibility for changes in your personal circumstances or work commitments which occur after the commencement of your course. Any course tuition fees outstanding are still due and payable.
5. **Transfers:** A transfer is defined as a change from one course to another within the same term. No fee applies to transfers.
6. To assist your budget, course tuition fees are charged on a per term basis rather than annually upfront. All continuing students are required to re-enrol each term at least one week prior to the start of term. You are ineligible to re-enrol or to receive a Transcript of Results or Certificate until all outstanding course tuition fees have been finalised.
7. The College reserves the right to vary course structure, teaching staff, adjust fees or class schedules at any time. It is at the College's discretion to discontinue offering a course or subject as deemed necessary.
8. The College reserves the right to cancel a course, or refuse any enrolment as permitted by law.
9. **Course Recognition:** Recognition of your elected course of study is available as pre-enrolment information and is published on the Course Outline. Professional Training Association recognition is determined by the Professional Association and maybe subject to change.
